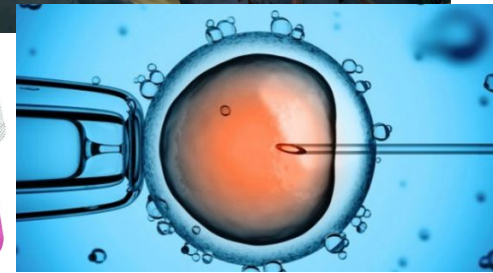
# Role of Health Education England
